

General Sanitizers and Disinfectants

How to know if they are approved:

- Must have an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) registration number.
- Must be registered with Colorado Department of Agriculture (CDA).
- Use the [National Pesticide Information Retrieval System](#) to check both EPA and CDA registrations.
- Follow all label instructions - especially concentration, contact time, method, and surfaces.



For Sanitizers

- The label says to use on food contact surfaces.
- The label does not say to rinse after use.

For Disinfectants

- The label says to use in hospitals
- The label says it is effective for *Salmonella choleraesuis (enteric)*, *Staphylococcus aureus*, and *Pseudomonas aeruginosa*
